
State of Iowa CDBG Program

o lowa's 2024 allocation is \$24,168,777

lowa's 2023 allocation was \$24,645,105

 IEDA received the funding agreement from HUD last Friday. We should receive our allocation soon after all parties sign the contract.

REMINDERS:

- EVERY CDBG project must meet ONE of the three listed National Objectives.
 - Benefit Low-to-Moderate Income Persons (Must be 70% of entire HUD allocation or greater.)
 - Slum & Blight Elimination
 - Urgent Need
- Eligible Applicants
 - All cities under 50,000 population (Including Cedar Falls)
 - All counties
 - City or County may apply on behalf of a non-profit entity.

- Some CDBG programs have an open application window.
- o Applications will be accepted and reviewed as funds are available.
- We anticipate review times will take 30-45 days to complete. This may change depending on demand/number of applications.
- Applications must be complete and thorough, or it could affect an application's eligibility.
- A community may only have ONE open active project per Funding Opportunity at a time.
 - Community X has an Open Active Water/Sewer project May not apply for another Water/Sewer project until prior project is closed-out with IEDA.
 - Community X has an Open Active DTR project They would be eligible to apply for a Water/Sewer project.

CDBG Water & Sewer applications will no longer be taken on a quarterly basis.

- Current round will close January 1, 2025
- Applications will re-open March 1, 2025. Close May 1, 2025
- Applications will re-open June 1, 2025. Close August 1, 2025.
- The permanent schedule starting in 2026 will be:
 - January 1, 2026
 - April 1, 2026

CDBG Community Facilities applications will be accepted and reviewed on an on-going basis as funds are available.

- We will review applications in the order in which they are received.
- IEDA will continue to accept applications and make awards as funds are available.
- Please Note: To make it easier for staff to monitor the Community Facilities applications, the application may no longer be left in "Editing" status indefinitely. After three months, if an application has not been submitted for consideration, staff will withdraw it.

Programs with an annual competitive round:

Downtown Revitalization

- Neighborhood Revitalization
 - Phase II applications ONLY. (Not open until early next year.)
 - No Planning grant will be available with the 2024 allocation.

Other CDBG Programs with an open application window will continue as such:

- Includes the following programs:
 - Career Link Employment Transportation
 - Opportunity and Threats
 - Sustainable Community Demonstration
- IEDA will continue to accept applications and make awards as funds are available.
- For all three applications, please check with CDBG staff on funding availability before applying.

ALL CDBG applications must include:

- Community Development and Housing Needs Assessment (Can only be a year old at time of application.)
- Minority Impact Statement
- Federal Assurance Signature Page (Signed by Mayor)
- Application/Recipient Disclosure/Update Form (Signed by Mayor)
- Public Hearing Documentation
 - Public Hearing Notice, Proof of Publication or Affidavit of Posting, and Signed Minutes


Resolution committing matching funds, if applicable.

Documentation of other funding sources.

Target area map, if applicable.

Any program specific items.

Applications are available now at www.iowagrants.gov.



 Applications must be submitted by 11:59 PM on application due date. The system will not accept applications after this date/time.

INCOMPLETE applications may not be reviewed or scored.

 Program specific application information will be covered in breakout sessions today.

 Changes to the applications from the prior year's application round will also be discussed in the breakout sessions.
