Before You Apply

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- This Year's Allocation ~ \$24,168,777
- National Objective:
 - Benefit to low- and moderate-income persons 2016-2020 American Community Survey data (on IEDA website)
 - Demonstrated by ACS data OR Income Survey
 - Limited clientele (presumed 51% LMI for Community Facilities and Services)
- Maximum eligibility is only (1) open / active project per Grantee per Program
 - If your community has an active grant award in a program, you must complete it before applying for more grant!

- Low- and Moderate Income Survey;
 - Must demonstrate proof of LMI / LMA <u>at time of application</u>
- Public Hearing Documentation;
 - Notice, Signed Minutes and Proof of Publication or Affidavit of Posting
- Community Development and Housing Needs Assessment 9 points;
- Minority Impact Statement;
- Federal Assurances, HUD Disclosures 2880;
 - Signed by the CEO, NOT CLERK!
- Commitment of Local Funds;
- Documentation of other funding sources;
- Target Area Map;

- Cost estimates must be within <u>12 months</u> of application;
- Water & Sewer: DNR inspection reports or correspondence;
- Copy of current rate ordinance for water & sewer districts;
- Procurement of A/E of record also recommended prior to application for Federal Crosscutting requirement inclusion;
- If seeking reimbursement, Federal procurement process of A/E services must be documented;
 - If budget does not match uploaded evidence of procurement, <u>applications will be</u> <u>considered incomplete;</u>

Potential Environmental Disqualifiers:

- □ Project site inside 100-year Floodplain?
 - (Assessed using the FFRMS mapping system)
- ☐ Choice Limiting Actions, such as (but not limited to):
 - Acquiring real property, Leasing property;
 - Demolishing a structure, Rehabilitating a property, Repairing a property;
 - Constructing a new building or structure;
 - Clearing, grading, or grubbing a site;
 - Construction bidding, Entering into a contract or commitment;
- □The project site has or is proximal to above-ground hazardous storage tanks;
- ☐ The project site has or is proximal to airports, railways or major roadways;

WATER AND SEWER FUND CDBG OVERVIEW

Water and Sewer Fund

Fund Maximum Awards

All applicants are eligible to apply for \$500,000 (regardless of community size)

» Eligible Activities

- Drinking Water Sources
 - Wells / Filtration Plants
- Water and wastewater treatment facilities
 - Expansion, rehabilitation, new construction
- Water distribution / wastewater collection systems
 - Rehabilitation, new construction, pipe-lining, removal of I&I
- Water Storage & Fire Flow Enhancements

Water and Sewer Fund

Application Cycle

- Current 3Q/4Q24 Applications due 1/01/2025
 - Award Announcements mid-month February
- Applications will only be accepted for (2) rounds in 2025 & 2026:
 - 1st Round: Open 3/01/25* and Due 5/01/2025
 - Award Announcements mid-month May
 - 2nd Round: Open 6/01/25 and Due 8/01/2025
 - Award Announcements mid-month August
 - 1st Round: Open 1/01/26 and Due 3/01/2026
 - Award Announcements mid-month April
 - 2nd Round: Open 4/01/26 and Due 6/01/2026
 - Award Announcements mid-month July
- Must be submitted in IowaGrants by 11:59 PM

Water and Sewer Fund

- Water & Sewer application <u>requirements</u>:
 - ➤ Demonstration of LMI: Via **2016-2020 ACS data** or provide completed Income Survey Report
 - ➤ Sewer Approved Facility Plan letter from IDNR;
 - ➤ Water Approved Preliminary Engineering Plan letter from IDNR;
 - ➤ Both minimum DNR Permit application submitted;
 - Approved DNR Permits score higher for demonstrating readiness!
 - ➤ Local match committed & documented:
 - If co-funded by SRF project must be on the <u>current</u> IUP Listing (<u>signed loan closing</u> letter preferred!)
 - If USDA-RD USDA letter of conditions must be provided

If required attachments are not submitted with the application, the application will not be reviewed

Competitive Elements!

- More competitive applications will also have (but not required):
 - ✓ Environmental review complete;
 - √ Final Plans & Specifications complete / Ready to Bid;
 - o CDBG will review front-end Specifications for most recent Federal Clauses
 - Architect/Engineer contracts must be Federally procured IAW 2CFR200 to be eligible costs
 - ✓ Applications that provide evidence of completed <u>and adopted</u> Capital Improvement plans and/or Asset Management Plans will receive additional points. This demonstrates the community has acknowledged the need to continue to plan for critical infrastructure investments.
 - ✓ All BABA compliance products identified for the project

Water/Sewer - Scored Elements

Quantitative Scores:

1) Degree to which CDBG funds will be leveraged by Other funds:

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1 Low = < 25%
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2 Medium/Low = 26% - 35%

3 Medium = 36% - 45%

4 Medium/High = 46% - 55%

5 High = > 55%

2) Percentage of LMI beneficiaries:

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1 Low = 51% - 55.9%
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2 Medium/Low = 56% - 59.9%

3 Medium =60% - 64.9%

4 Medium/High = 65% - 69.9%

5 High = > 70%

3) Degree to which the cost per beneficiary is within a reasonable range:

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1 \text{ Low} = > $10,000 \text{ per beneficiary}
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2 Medium/Low = \$8,001 - \$10,000

3 Medium = \$6,5001 - \$8,000

4 Medium/High = \$5,001 - \$6,500

5 High = < \$5,000

Water/Sewer - Scored Elements

Qualitative Scores:

Scoring rankings:

- 1 Low = Limited documentation provided
- 2 Medium/Low = Little support shown, but minimal documentation provided
- **3 Medium =** Full support not evident and or no supplemental documents provided
- 4 Medium/High = Strong support documented by all parties involved
- 5 High = Strong support documented and supplemental documents provided
- 4) Magnitude of Need for project:
- 5) Degree to which the project demonstrates the ability to start construction within 6 months of award and complete within the 3-year Period of Performance:
- 6) Ratio of proposed CDBG funds to Applicants SECURED Local Match:
- 7) Potential degree of impact the Activity will have on the identified need and the standard of living / quality of life of proposed beneficiaries:
- 8) Degree of Financial Impact to the proposed beneficiaries:
- 9) Capacity of the Applicant to operate and maintain the proposed infrastructure:

Competitive Readiness Elements

- √ Federal procurement of A/E prior to submittal of application
- ✓ Other funding agencies commitments
 - o On SRF approved IUP, USDA Letter of Conditions, City Resolution of Match
- ✓ Approved Preliminary Engineering Report / Facilities Plan
- ✓ Copy of Construction Permit application to DNR
- ✓ Environmental review complete (not required)
- √ Final design completed or underway
- ✓BABA Compliance items identified
- √ Asset Management / Capital Improvement Plans



COMMUNITY FACILITIES & SERVICES FUND CDBG OVERVIEW

Community Facilities and Services Fund

» Fund Ceilings

• All applicants are eligible to apply for \$600,000 (regardless of community size)

Eligible Activities

- Childcare Centers
- Facilities for persons with disabilities
- Senior Centers
- Homeless Shelters
- Food Pantries



Community Facilities and Services Fund

Application Cycle

- ➤ Open / rolling application window
 - o 'Idle' applications not submitted will be deleted after 3 months!
- >Applications will be reviewed as they are submitted
- >Awards will be made until all funds are obligated

Community Facilities and Services Fund

Application Requirements:

- ➤ Demonstration of National Objectives:
 - o **LMI**: Via 2016-2020 ACS data or provide Income Survey Report
 - <u>Limited Clientele:</u> Abused Children, Abused Spouses, Elderly, Disabled Adults, Homeless, Illiterate Adults, Persons with AIDS, Migrant Farm Workers
- ➤ Site Control demonstrated by either:
 - Ownership as long as it is purchased prior to the application submittal date
 - An <u>option</u> on the parcel secured with money (if necessary)
- >Local match committed & documented

If required documentation is not submitted with the application, the application will not be reviewed

Community Facilities & Services- Application Checklist

Is the UEI documentation provided?

Is the grant amount requested at or below the amount allowable?

Is the administration line 10% or less of CDBG amount AND of total cost?

Is the "Construction, Professional Fees, & Permit Administration" budget table completed?

Is the public hearing publication date no less than 4 days but no more than 20 days prior to the hearing?

Does the public hearing notice contain correct & necessary information?

Do the public hearing minutes cover the 9 required points and include correct and necessary information?

Is the HUD Disclosure statement completed and signed by the CEO?

(If Yes on Part 1 Question #2, then Parts II and III must also be completed)

Is federal assurances page signed by the <u>CEO</u>?

Is the Community Needs Assessment current?

(good for one year only, then must be re-adopted; the minutes and proof of publication must both be re-uploaded)

Have all documents under Required Attachments been uploaded?

(NOTE: Income Survey Reports are required attachments if an Income Survey was provided!)

Community Facilities & Services – Key Points

- ➤ Need for the Project
- ➤ Timely Start and Completion
 - Realistic construction start date and overall timetable to complete project
- Local Funds Leveraged
 - o % of project leveraged with city funds and/or other contributions
- ➤ Cost Per Beneficiary
 - < \$10,000 CDBG dollars / beneficiary
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- ➤ Capacity to Operate Facility
 - Subrecipient staffing plans, etc.

Community Facilities & Services – Key Points

- Local Funds Committed or Secured
- ➤ Site control if acquisition is necessary
 - Option to Purchase
- > Readiness to proceed
 - Procurement of A/R, Plans & Specs Developed, Environmental
- ➤ Will Meet National Objective After Completion
 - Certain projects may need to complete survey before AND after project

Readiness To Proceed

- ✓ Federal procurement of A/E prior to submittal of application
- ✓ Final design completed or underway
- ✓ Other funding commitments
 - o City Resolution of Match, Subrecipient Agreements, Match Resolutions
- ✓ Environmental review complete (not required)
- √BABAA Compliance items identified

Community Facilities & Services Review Criteria

- Magnitude of need for the project
- ❖Degree to which project can be completed in a timely manner
- Degree to which CDBG funds will be leveraged by other funds
- Cost per beneficiary
- Degree of impact project will have on identified need & quality of life
- Readiness to proceed
- Capacity to operate and maintain proposed project
- **❖LMI** benefit
- Green Streets Criteria optional

Application Reminders

- ✓ If an application is incomplete it will NOT be reviewed.
 - Complete means all required documents are uploaded <u>and</u> include all necessary information.
 - IEDA will not give applicants an opportunity to "fix" applications or supplement information.
- ✓ Project planning should begin well in advance of the grant application!
 - Water & Sewer: Facility Plan or Preliminary Engineering Report with the IDNR letter of approval - is <u>required</u> with application.
- ✓ Documentation of local matching funds must be included.
- ✓ Copy of DNR Construction Permit application (within 6 mos of application submission)
- ✓ Water & Sewer application round schedules will be modified in 2025 and 2026
