Approval of Minutes - April 19, 2024 IEDA Meeting

MOTION: Tom Townsend moved that the IEDA Board approve the minutes of the April 19, 2024 IEDA Board meeting, seconded by Melissa Ballard. Motion carried unanimously.

Enceinte Health, Inc.: Des Moines - Request to Amend Contract Terms

True360, Inc.: Des Moines - Request to Amend Contract Terms

<u>MOTION</u>: Melissa Ballard moved that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board accept the recommendation of the TCC to approve the request to defer loan payments for 12 months, seconded by Jennifer Steffensmeier. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATION

Vemerald, LLC - Davenport

Communities may exempt from taxation all or a portion of the actual value added by improvements to real property directly related to new jobs created by a High Quality Jobs (HQJ) project and used in the operations of the eligible business. The exemption may be allowed for a period not to exceed twenty years.

MOTION: Mark Kittrell moved that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board accept the recommendation of the DDC to acknowledge that the City of Davenport has approved a 20-year 60% property tax exemption with an estimated value of \$161,000,000, seconded by Tom Townsend. Roll Call vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Belling & Meyer, LLC dba Bovi-Jet - Proof of Commercial Relevance

MOTION: Doug Boone moved that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board accept the recommendation of the TCC to approve a \$50,000 Proof of Commercial Relevance loan with standard POCR royalty terms: repayment amount is 1 times the award amount paid back at a royalty rate of 3% of total gross revenue, which does not include grant funds, for a calendar year with each payment due on June 1 of the following calendar year, seconded by Lisa Shimkat. Motion carried unanimously.

Incentit – Demonstration Fund/Proof of commercial Relevance

MOTION: Mark Kittrell moved that the lowa Economic Development Authority Board accept the recommendation of the TCC to deny the application for a \$70,000 Demonstration Fund award and approve a \$50,000 Proof of Commercial Relevance loan with standard POCR loan terms: 0% rate of interest, a 5-year loan term, and a 6-month deferral, seconded by Melissa Ballard. Motion carried unanimously.

REDEVELOPMENT TAX CREDIT PROGRAM FOR BROWNFIELDS AND GRAYFIELDS

Contract 21-BTC-22 - Request to Amend Contract

<u>MOTION</u>: Lisa Shimkat moved to approve the recommendation of the Brownfield Advisory Counsel to deny the request to amend Contract 21-BTC-22 to extend the Project Completion Period from 42 to 54 months, seconded by Melissa Ballard. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF VENDORS

MOTION: Tom Townsend moved that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board authorize IEDA to enter into contracts as follows:

- A. Orissa International Pte. Ltd: \$91,800 for trade and direct foreign investment services in Taiwan and Southeast Asia;
- B. Covered Bridge consulting, LLC: \$84,000 for direct foreign investment services in Japan;
- C. Tractus Asia Ltd.: \$265,000 for trade and direct foreign investment services in East and South Asia;
- D. Market Intelligence Latin America (MILA): \$120,000 for trade and direct foreign investment services in Mexico and Latin America;
- E. Cloudburst Consulting, Inc.: \$163,627 for development of CDBG Consolidated Plan for IEDA and a housing analysis for IFA, with costs shared by IEDA and the Iowa Finance Authority;
- F. CDS Global Inc.: \$160,000 for tourism fulfillment services; and
- G. VentureNet Iowa, LLC: \$698,000 to perform due diligence for applications for financial assistance through IEDA's Innovation Platform and post-award services
