The General Nonpoint Source loan program offers municipalities affordable financing and technical assistance for a variety of water quality projects.

Eligible Practices

- · Stream bank stabilization
- · Wetlands
- · Stormwater best management practices
- · Restoration of native habitat
- · Source water protection practices
- · Landfill closure
- · Remediation of storage tanks

Eligible Applicants

Must be an owner of record or have longterm control of the property where the project is to be implemented.

Incentive Opportunity

0% interest on first \$500,000 borrowed

Loan Terms


- Loans can be used to match local, state and federal grants
- Planning and Design loan at 0% can be rolled into construction loan
- Loan amount can be up to 100% of the project costs
- · No minimum or maximum loan amount
- · Loan terms can be up to 20 years
- · No early repayment penalty
