

## 2025 U.S. and Iowa Ag Exports



*Below is summary export data obtained from WISERTrade on Iowa-focused protein and grain commodities. The report contains Full-Year 2025 trade data, including projected agriculture adjusted data by state-of-origin/source of commodity for those overseas trade markets from January-December 2025.*

### Full Year 2025 Highlights

- **Pork exports sustain growth through the end of 2025:**
  - U.S. pork export totals reached \$6.3 billion in 2025. It was the second highest value and third largest volume on record. Iowa remained the nation's top exporter at \$2.1 billion.
  - Mexico imports experienced 9.3% growth from 2024 to 2025, another record.
  - Central America countries continued to show impressive growth, while Japan, Korea and Canada pork exports softened.
- **U.S. corn exports accelerate to meet demand:**
  - Total corn exports totaled \$18.8 billion for full-year 2025, with a 33% increase year-over-year and just shy of the 2021 export market record in value.
  - Iowa remains the top export state, with 17% of total U.S. exports.
  - Mexico exceeded expectations once again, with exports totaling \$6.0 billion.
  - Japan and Korea – now 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> largest exports – saw major growth, boosting those North Asia markets by \$1.8 billion in export growth compared to 2024 data.
- **U.S. soybean market feels the effects of tariffs:**
  - U.S. soybean exports fell by roughly \$8.1 billion year-over-year, with Iowa producers experiencing over \$1 billion of that lost market based on state export numbers/value.
  - China's purchases collapsed in June-Oct. 2025, resulting in a \$9.5 billion decrease compared to 2024, and \$12 billion decrease compared to 2023. Total 2024 sales were \$3.0 billion. Dec. 2025 exports to China were a positive \$595 million, signaling trade hopes for 2026.
- **Fresh and frozen beef exports see gentle decline after increases in '23 to '24:**
  - Overall, U.S. beef exports were the largest for December in eight months. However, full-year 2025 shipments were lower compared to 2024 due to the significant drop from China.
  - Japan and Korea experienced mild year-over-year dips, as did Mexico, both on fresh and frozen.
  - Iowa maintains 4<sup>th</sup> national ranking in fresh and frozen beef exports.
- **Egg exports dip below 2024 totals, but show some stabilization:**
  - U.S. liquid/dried egg exports continue to recomb, with notable growth year-over-year from Iowa and Minnesota.
  - Iowa represented 40% of 2025 U.S. liquid/dried egg exports at \$34.5 million.



## Beef Exports – Fresh/Chilled (HS0201)



## Egg Exports – Liquid/Dried (HS0408)








