Executive Summary

2024 CDBG-DR Quarter Ending 12/31/2025

The State of Iowa received a grant agreement for \$134,687,000 effective July 11, 2025, under Pub. L. 118-158 for recovery from the June 2024 Midwest Flooding (FEMA DR-4796-IA). The State's Action Plan prioritizes housing, infrastructure, mitigation, planning, and administration in HUD-identified and grantee-identified MID areas.

During this initial quarter, the State focused on program development and launch activities. No projects were awarded; however, administrative funds were obligated. The State also completed a substantial amendment to add Lyon, Buena Vista, and Pottawattamie counties as eligible Grantee-Identified MID areas.

As of quarter end, the State has obligated \$6,734,350 of the total \$134,687,000 allocation.

Next quarter, the State anticipates opening FEMA HMGP Buyout applications.
